



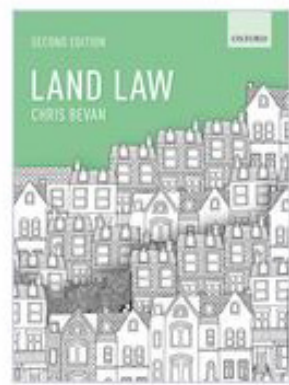
Discovering content on *Law Trove*



There are several ways of discovering content on Law Trove...

Option 1: DOI links

DOI links are the best way of directing your students to a specific book or chapter. DOI links can be easily shared via VLEs and reading lists. Find them on every book and chapter page.



Land Law (2nd edn)

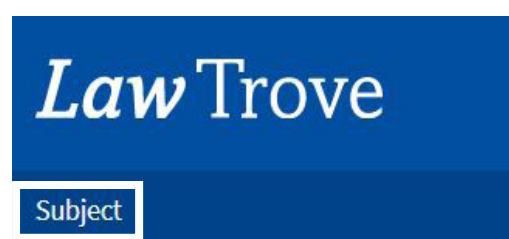

Option 2: Subject menu

You can browse the content for a specific subject using the 'Subject' button on the homepage (e.g. for tort law). All relevant content, including both chapters and books, will be returned in alphabetical order. Using the left-hand 'Modify your search' menu, you can filter your search by looking for keywords under the 'Term' option, or you can use the 'Format' option to look at book content only.

Option 3: Search

Law Trove has an incredibly powerful search engine. Type a word or phrase into the search bar on the homepage to dive in. Use the 'Modify your search' menu on the left to search for even more specific content (e.g. search for 'Adverse possession', then add an extra term and search for 'squatting'). You can also use the 'Modify your search' menu to search for a specific author or title.
